


The Problem




The role of the business analyst

What is SOA:

Service-oriented architecture (**SOA**) is a <u>software design</u> and software architecture <u>design pattern</u> based on discrete pieces of software providing application functionality as services to other applications (Wikipedia)

Benefits:


- Speeds up business changes

SOA continued


SOA is NOT:

- Only technical/IT initiative






Tightly coupled vs Loosely coupled
